### What qualification will I gain?

- Extended Diploma 62 credits must be completed
- Diploma any combination of units to a minimum of 38 credits must be completed
- Certificate any combination of units to a minimum of 13 credits must be completed
- Award a minimum of 6 credits must be completed

#### How will it be assessed?

Written and practical assignments and a work based project
